SECTION II: Activity Profile

A. Introduction to Terms: Some words pertaining to organic handling have certain meanings. To aid in understanding, Americert would like to clarify how certain words used in this Intake Form are defined.

1. Brand owner is a company that contracts out the processing and/or packaging of organic products. Examples include:

(a) A brand owner who uses copackers to produce or pack certified organic products or crops into the brand owner's labels for distribution by the brand owner.

(b) An operation that handles or distributes any organic products which are not packaged by them, but which list them as the distributor (or the entity packed for) on the label or packaging.

2. **Copackers** are operations that manufacture, process, pack, repack, label, re-label, or otherwise handle products or crops on behalf of this operation and package the product in this operation's brand or on this operation's behalf.

3. **Copacking** means handling, manufacturing, or packing any organic products where the final packaging identifies another entity or company as the handler or distributor of the product and does not identify this operation as the handler or packer.

4. Handle means to sell, process, or package agricultural products. Examples include, but are not limited to, trading, facilitating sale or trade on behalf of a seller or oneself, importing to the United States, exporting for sale in the United States, combining, aggregating, culling, conditioning, treating, packing, containerizing, repackaging, labeling, storing, receiving, or loading.

5. Nonprocessor means any operation that does not produce, pack, label, or otherwise process organic items. Examples of such operations are sellers, brokers, traders, distributors, brand owners, and storage facilities.

6. Organic items include organic crops, ingredients, or products.

7. **Process/Processor** includes such activities as cooking, baking, heating, drying, mixing, grinding, churning, separating, extracting, cutting, fermenting, eviscerating, pre-serving, dehydrating, freezing, or otherwise manufacturing, and includes packaging, canning, jarring, or otherwise enclosing food in a container. For purposes of these Modules, it also includes operations that pack, label, or relabel.

8. Unpackaged means the organic item is not enclosed in a container. Products are also considered unpackaged when the container is the vehicle it is transported in (e.g., tanker of oil, rail car of grain).
